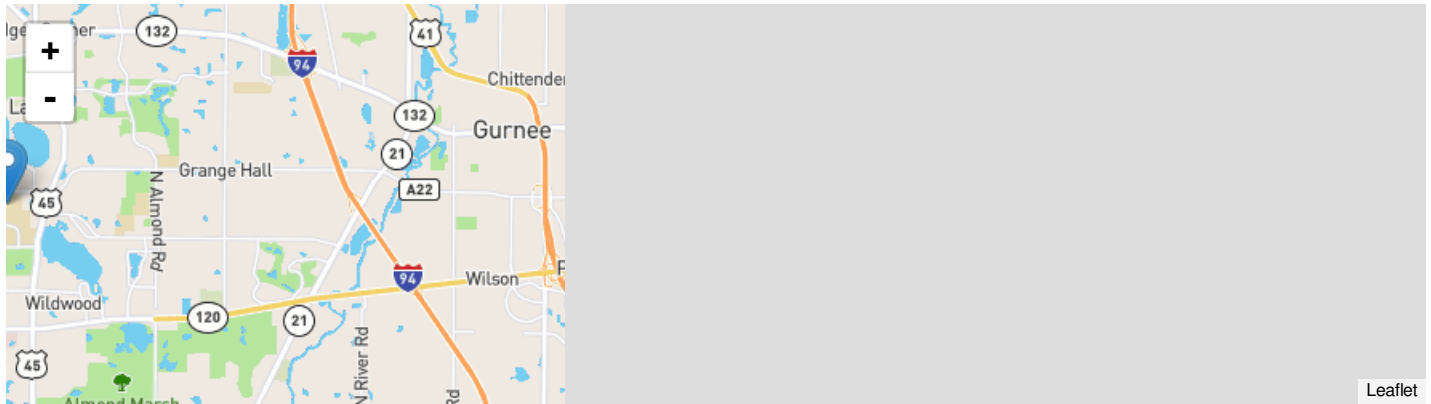


Personal Success Program ^[1]
